

Installing the Dashboards

The dashboard is an analysis tool that displays live data in the form of a table or graph.

Components

The dashboard is comprised of the following files:

- dashboard.war
- dashboard.properties
- loom-dashboard-ejb.jar - as a connector to TIM

Installation

In order to install the dashboard, the **dashboard.war** file must be saved in TIM's deploy-directory.



```
C:\tim\jboss<version>\standalone\deployments\
```

The **dashboard.properties** file must be shifted to the **\configuration** directory in the JBoss-directory.

```
C:\tim\jboss<version>\standalone\configuration\
```

The **loom-dashboard-ejb.jar** file must, if applicable, be shifted to the **\tim.ear** directory in the JBoss-directory.

```
C:\tim\jboss<version>\standalone\deployments\tim.ear\
```

In order for the dashboard to be able to access the currently-installed version of TIM, the **dashboard.properties** must be configured with an editor. In **Line 1**, the port for the **wsdlHost** must be adapted for TIM.

Example

The address for TIM clients is: <http://meinefirmenserver:8383/loom-portal/>. The wsdlHost must then be as follows:

```
wsdlHost=http://127.0.0.1:8383/
```
