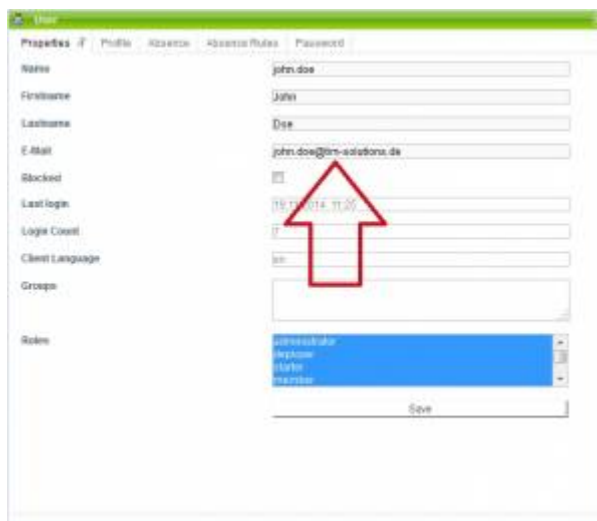

Types of registration

There are three options for registration at T!M

Registration with your e-mail address

Every user can register with the e-mail address which has been deposited to him, if the corresponding password is correct.



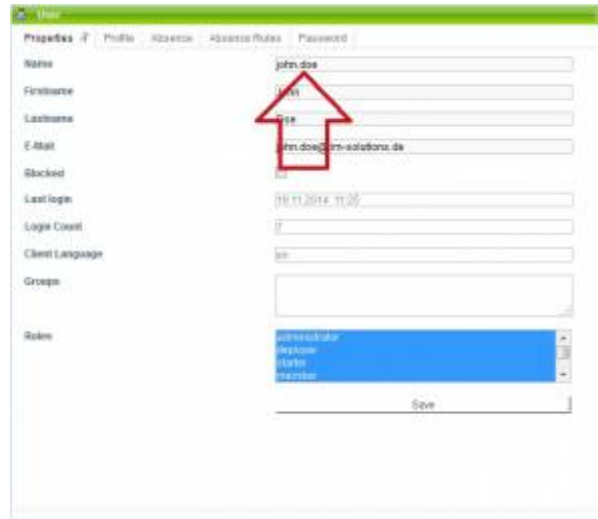
At T!M, e-mail addresses have to be **distinct** for every user (system-wide)

Registration with client and user name

It is also possible to register with your user name. In order for T!M to know for which **client** the user wants to register, this has to be specified as a prefix according to the following form:

client/name

You can find your name in `client_profile`.
