


Types of registration

There are three options for registration at TIM

Registration with your e-mail address

Every user can register with the e-mail address which has been deposited to him, if the corresponding password is correct.

It is also possible to register with your user name. In order for TIM to know for which [client](#) the user wants to register, this has to be specified as a prefix according to the following form:

client/name
