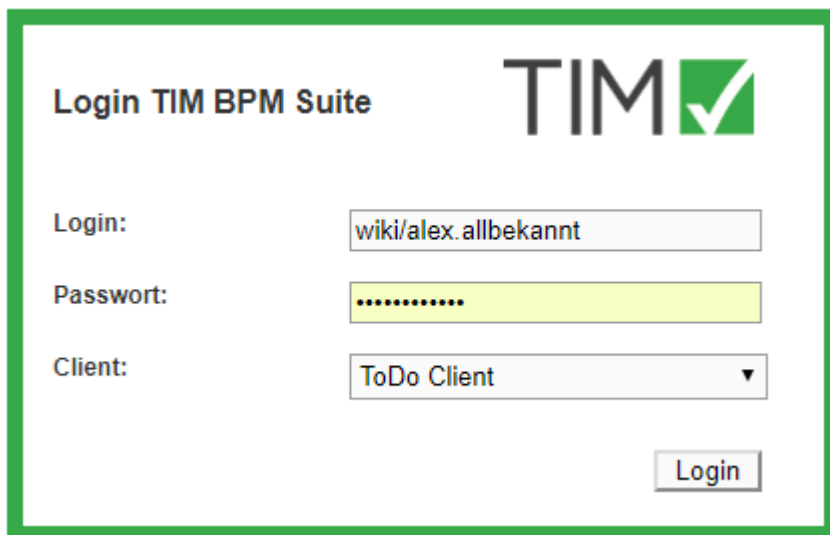


Login Screen

Generally, the mask for the login/registration consists of the following components/fields:

- **Login:** Here, there are three ways to enter your registration data: see [Types of registration](#)
- **Password:** Here, the assigned password is entered
- **Client:** Here, the user can choose between the different clients that are available for log-in. A successful registration for specific clients depends on the rights that have been assigned to a particular user.
