

Swimlanes

One company can be subdivided into several smaller subdivisions. These divisions can be represented in the process modeling through so-called "Swimlanes". A Swimlane can be assigned to a specific user or a group for further processing.

All activities and tasks within a Swimlane can be assigned via predefined assignments.

Sometime Tasks must be assigned directly to one person and not to a group. Therefore Version [v4.3](#) has the possibility to assign a task directly by calling this syntax

```
group(<GRUPPENNAME>)->member(<MEMBERSHIPNAME>)
```

Beispiel

In this example we will search for a [membership](#) called "**Freising**". Its also possible to use [Processvariables](#) to hand over Membership-Names.

```
group(work council)->member(${city})
```
