## Swimlanes

One company can be subdivided into several smaller subdivisions. These divisions can be represented in the process modeling through so-called "Swimlanes". A Swimlane can be assigned to a specific user or a group for further processing.

All activities and tasks within a Swimlane can be assigned via predefined assignments. Sometime Tasks must be assigned directly to one person and not to a group. Therefore Version v4.3 has the possibility to assign a task directly by calling this syntax

group(<GRUPPENNAME>)->member(<MEMBERSHIPNAME>)

## **Beispiel**

In this example we will search for a membership called **"Freising"**. Its also possible to use **Processvariables** to hand over Membership-Names.

group(work council)->member(\${city})
