### remindInPercentBeforeEnd

Percentage to be escalated before the end of the node. Example: If the parameter is 40, it will escalate when 60% of the processing time for this node is reached. (Node has duration 10h (1000) then it is escalated at 40 after 6h).

### assignee

Who should be notified of the escalation. (see [MailReminderHandler](#))

## limit

Number of escalations to be created at each call.

### IMPORTANT!

If this number is too large possibly no escalations will be created.
