Description

This timer runs all reminders up until it hits the limit. There it searches for and executes open reminders, for example, those generated by the [GenerateOffsetEscalationTimeHandler](#). In other words, the timer ensures the dispatching of reminder emails which have already accumulated due to escalations.
