

# createProcessInstanceByCSVHandler

## Description

This handler reads all of the files in a folder, starts a process instance for every CSV-file, and names it after the file. The file is then attached to the process.

---

## Timer Name

any

## Web service Name

ProcessInstanceManager

## Web service Method

createProcessInstancesByHandler

## Parameter

### Process definition

Name of the process definition to-be started.

### File path

Path to the folder from which the file is to be read.

### Name of the process instance

The name is taken from the columns of the CSV file. For example, if 1~2 is given with the parameter, the resulting name will be Spalte1Spalte2.

## Limit

Here, a maximum for the number of runs that a timer undergoes may be set for the instance.

**Caution!** The file will not be moved.
