

Types of Registration

There are three ways to register using TIM

Registration with an e-mail address

Every user can register with the e-mail address that has been assigned to them, as long as the corresponding password is correct.

At TIM, each user requires a **distinct** e-mail address (system-wide)

Registration with client and username

It is also possible to register via username. In order for TIM to know for which [client](#) the user wants to register, this has to be provided as a prefix in accordance with the following form:

```
client/name
```

The name can be found in the [client profile](#).
