

Make a query

“Make a query” is a special kind of [AdHoc Task](#). The functionality and the creation are the same like AdHoc Tasks. The difference is, that “make a query” interrupts the current task, so it doesn't appear in the tasklist of the user any more. The “make a query” is assigned to another user. As soon as the “query” is done, the original task gets active again. The remaining time waited for the query and is on the same level as before the query.
